



What is a Corporate Water Footprint?

Corporate Water Footprint

is the total water used by a business to produce its goods or services.

It includes both water used during production and manufacturing

as well as water used in the supply chain.



The water footprint of 1 kg of beef is approximately 15 thousand liters

Direct Water Footprint

aka the operational water footprint is the direct water used

for producing, manufacturing or supporting activities

by a business or organization



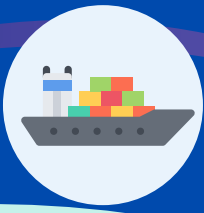
About one fifth of the global water footprint relates to production

Indirect Water Footprint

aka supply-chain water footprint is the water footprint of

the inputs and products used in the supply chain

and production activities of a business or organization



Agricultural production contributes about 92% to the global water footprint
